Special Program Themes

The *Fairfield Duo*, possessing a diverse repertoire, can create programs to coordinate with special themed events such as gallery exhibitions, celebrations of world cultures, Women's History Month and more. Themed programs, such as those suggested below, may highlight music from historical eras, geographic regions or trends in art:



Japonisme -- An exhibition at the World's Fair of 1867 brought Japanese arts and crafts to Paris as well as new influences on the works of artists such as Edgar Degas, Mary Cassatt and Claude Monet. As the trademark concert in the Fairfield Duo's unique programming, arrangements of traditional Japanese music are programmed with French Impressionist and early 20th-century works. These concerts may include performances featuring *shakuhachi*, the traditional Japanese bamboo flute.

Nocturnes & Lullabies -- Beautiful and lyrical night songs by Classical and Romantic Era composers

Americans in Paris -- Celebrating French music from the Renaissance through the Modern Age

Music of the Americas -- Selections by composers from the United States, Argentina, Cuba, Brazil, Paraguay, and more

Mediterranean Magic -- A wonderfully pleasing program of music from Italy, France and Spain

International Blend -- Audiences can stamp their musical passport music as the ensemble explores music from the Americas, Europe, British Isles, Middle East and Asia

Renaissance to Realtime -- A musical journey through the 16th-21st centuries including modern commissions and works by composers close to the duo

Fairfield Duo – Plus One --Guitar and flute -- plus clarinet, violin, oboe, or cello

Go for Baroque -- Music of Bach, Vivaldi, Telemann, Handel, Couperin, Loeillet, and more
